The Division of Human Resources would like to welcome all employees to the 2016-17 school year. We look forward to an exciting and successful year.

WorkKeys to Replace NCLB

Effective this school year, Human Resources will no longer require classified employees to attend No Child Left Behind (NCLB) classes. Instead, the WorkKeys test will be administered for those recommended for hire into classified positions where duties include instructional support and classroom responsibilities. WorkKeys is a job skills test that will assist APS in hiring highly qualified classified staff to promote student achievement. The three tests that will be administered are reading, writing and math, requiring approximately 50 minutes per section to complete. The test generates a score to measure candidate's skills. The WorkKeys test will replace the former Accuplacer exam, spelling and clerical tests.
